## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XIX OF THE "REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF DEAL, 1982" FLOODPLAIN MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE BOROUGH OF DEAL HEREBY ORDAIN:

## **SECTION 1. RECITALS.**

That Chapter XIX, Floodplain Management Regulations, of the "Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of Deal, 1982" be and hereby is amended in the following particulars:

## 102.2 Establishment of Flood Hazard Areas.

2) Federal Best Available Information. The Borough of Deal shall utilize Federal flood information as listed in the table below that provides more detailed hazard information, including flood elevations, and flood hazard areas, which were developed post Superstorm Sandy. This information may include but is not limited to preliminary flood elevation guidance from FEMA (such as Advisory Flood Hazard Area Maps, Work Maps or Preliminary FIS and FIRM). Additional Federal Best Available studies issued after the date of this ordinance must also be considered. These studies are listed on FEMA's Map Service Center. This information shall be used for floodplain regulation purposes only.
