CAPITAL ORDINANCE NO. 1278

CAPITAL ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE ACQUISITION OF A FIRE TRUCK AND APPROPRIATING \$2,337,542.39 THEREFOR, AUTHORIZED IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF DEAL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Deal, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey (the "Borough") has determined to provide for the acquisition of a fire truck; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has available \$2,337,542.39 in the Borough's Capital Improvement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF DEAL, IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The improvements described in Section 2 of this ordinance are hereby authorized as general capital improvements to be undertaken in and by the Borough. For the improvements or purposes described in Section 2, there is hereby appropriated \$2,337,542.39, said sum being inclusive of \$2,337,542.39 from the Borough's Capital Improvement Fund.
- Section 2. The improvements hereby authorized to be undertaken consist of the acquisition of a fire truck, together with all purposes necessary, incidental or appurtenant thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with contracts, plans, specifications or requisitions therefor on file with or through the Borough Clerk, as finally approved by the governing body of the Borough.
- Section 3. The 2024 capital budget of the Borough will conform to the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Borough Clerk and is available there for public inspection.
- Section 4. The Borough Attorney and other Borough officials and representatives are hereby authorized to do all things necessary to accomplish the purposes of the appropriation made herein.
 - Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect as provided by law.
